Nepal is one of the poorest and least developed countries the world with many of its population living below the poverty line. Our

goal is to create a global family for the poor and needy children so they feel safe and loved within the orphanage.

We are very pleased to receive many generous donations from individuals and organizations which help us to continue the work we have started in Pokhara.

The Women's Empowerment Project (Handicraft Centre) provides training which gives these women the opportunity to receive paid employment, social security and a home for their families. The women are producing items of excellent quality such as hats, bags, wallets,



Our glass project is the only program in Nepal so far which makes glassware from drawings done by the children

Our hearing aid project provides free examination and a free hearing aid to those people who have been suffering hearing problems and have no money to buy a hearing aid.

Our "Catch the Fish" project offers a chance for poor people to start a small business such as buffalo or goat farming, run a tea shop or vegetable shop, use a sewing machine for making clothes or be a street vendor.

Future plans of NCH:

- To purchase land and build a permanent home for the children incorporating a health clinic and elderly person's complex.
- To extend the Women's Empowerment Project.

Supporting an orphanage in Pokhara, nepal

This charity was set up in March 2005 to provide funds for Namaste Children's House in Pokhara, Nepal. The charity has a committee on the Isle of Man who meet regularly to discuss ways in which money can be raised to support the orphanage.

At NCH we aim to provide the following for the children:

- Care
- Education and healthcare
- A sense of family, community & cultural identity
- A high standard of nutrition
- Vocational training.



Namaste Children's House was opened in June 2003 when it was obvious that there was a desperate need for yet another orphanage in Pokhara especially as so many children had lost their parents in

floods, landslides, through drugs, disease and alcohol, as well as the violent conflict between the rebel camps of various groups and the government. The country is now experiencing a stable form of government so we hope that peace will continue in this beautiful place.

The organization has leased two homes at Lakeside and Damside, Pokhara for over 100 children from different parts of Nepal who are aged from 15 months to seventeen years. The trained staff are responsible for the care of the children, the maintenance of the building, accounting & administrative duties all under the supervision of Mr. Visma Raj Paudel who has many years' experience in the field of child welfare.

The chairman of NCH-IOM, John Riley, has been involved with the orphanage since it opened. NCH-IOM is now the main source of funding for the orphanage. Most of the children are sponsored by people on the Island in the UK.

We hope you would like to sponsor a child in the orphanage for at least £20 a month (60p a day!)

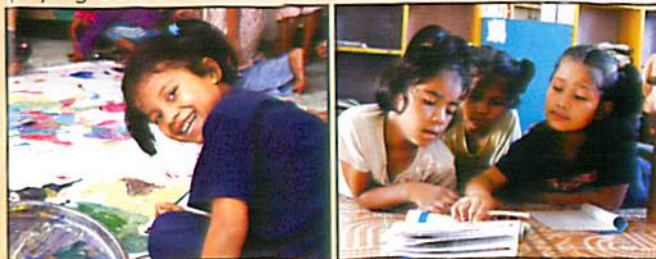


This amount of £20 is only our recommendation, but this will help towards the cost of caring for each child in the orphanage. It will provide them with their meals, accommodation, school fees and uniform, medicine and health care.

All you need to do is complete the form and return it to the chairman. We will then send you details of a child for you to sponsor. Every six months you will receive a report, photograph of your child and other items such as a letter and/or a drawing.

If you do not wish to sponsor a child but would like to make a donation then there are always other needs we have in the orphanage. For example, £200 will treat the children to a day's outing and picnic, £50 will buy art supplies, and there are many other items you can purchase starting from £10.

We also have a Scholarship Scheme where we are able to help children who are from very poor homes to continue their education. We pay their school fees, provide them with a daily meal, buy school uniform and materials. These children can be sponsored by paying £10 a month.
