

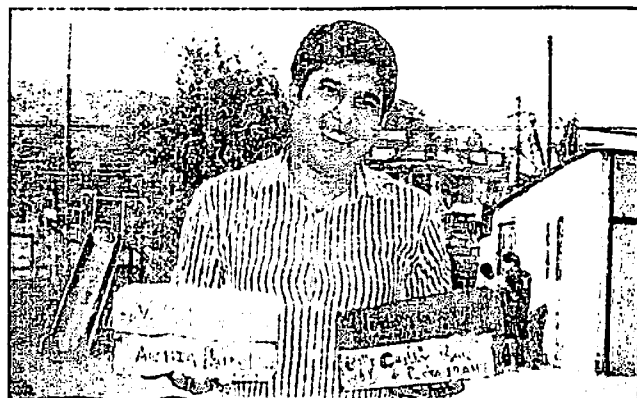
How you can help us:

- f) Encourage others to get involved in such a worthwhile project.

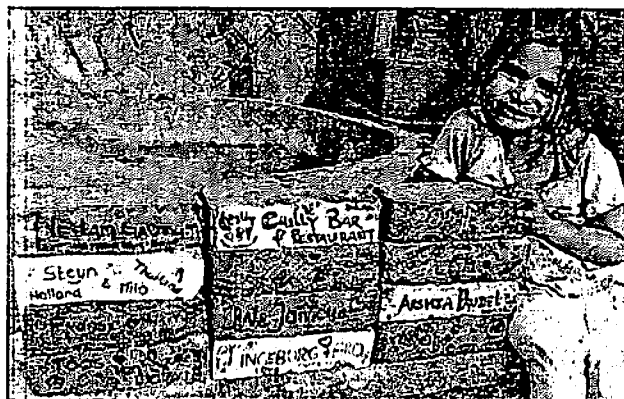
The name of the donor will remain on a commemorative metal plate (for donations above £1,000 so all people can recognize the value of your contribution.

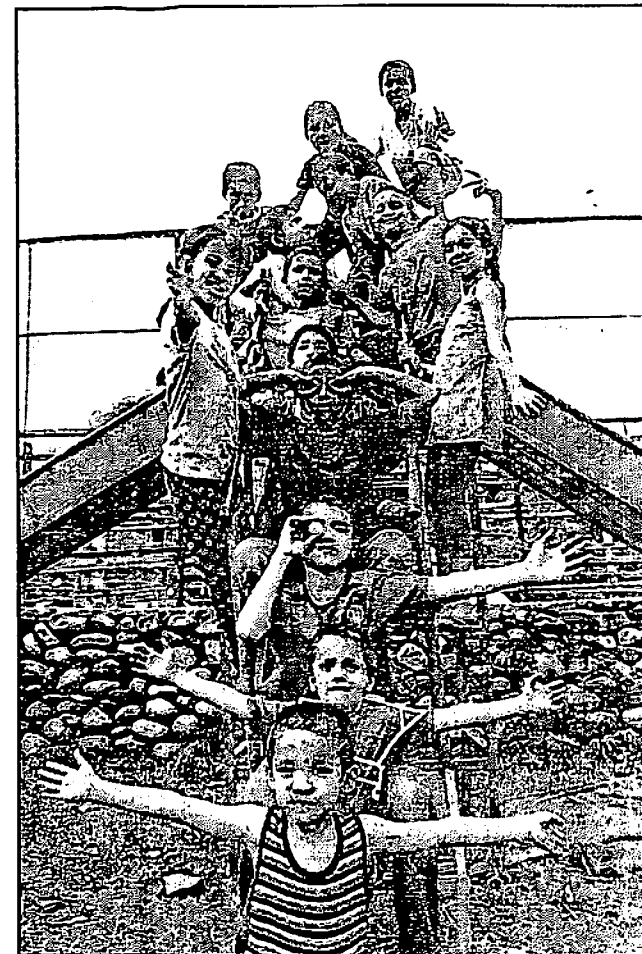

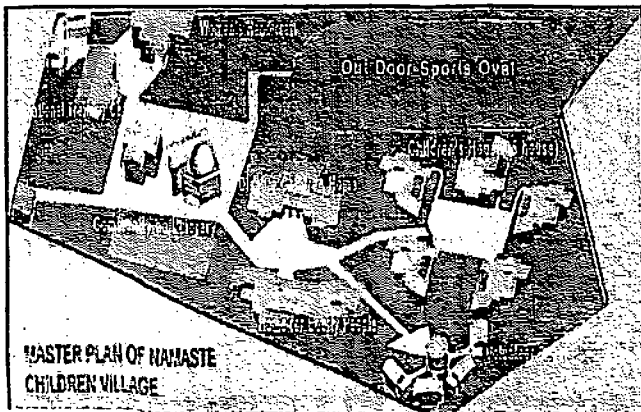

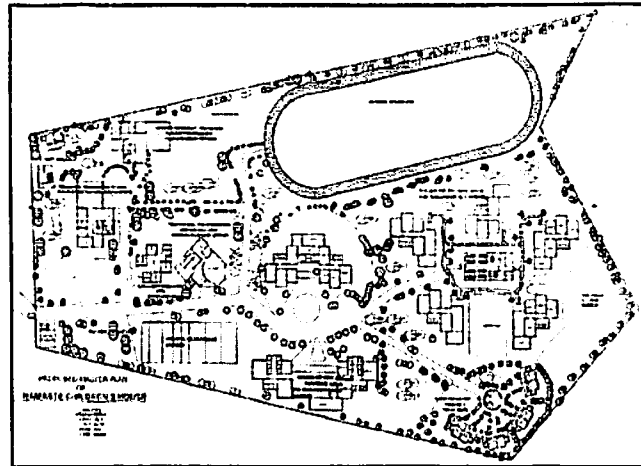
Namaste Children's House (NCH) is a non profit social organization which is supporting the underprivileged children, women and people of Nepal through its various projects.

One of the most important projects we have been working on for the past 12 months is the building of the Namaste Village. The lease of our current building expires in December 2012, and our goal is that the Namaste Village will be established before then.

Phase one of our project includes purchasing the land; building five children's homes, a library/meeting room, administrative offices, storeroom and guard's house. The village will include various landscaping measures such as roads, paths and fencing. We will focus on caring for the environment by utilizing environmentally sustainable practices and technologies to reduce its impact, and set an example to others in Nepal. An organic vegetable garden will provide healthy food as well as enabling self-sufficiency. We will include bio gas systems, a solar cooking system, botanical garden, small farm and a meditation centre.



The cost of the 11 buildings will be **£588,680.56** and we hope to find many donors that will help us. The new village will be able to accommodate many more children; we intend to raise the number of children in our care from the current level of 80 to around 375 kids. The library and the health post will be open to local families and children so that many more people can access health treatments, care and education.



The vocational centre will provide electricity, plumbing and computer training for children, give them job hunting guidance and teach skills to help them find a job after school. We will continue to support many women and their children through the Women's Empowerment Project which will provide training on sewing techniques and help Nepali women become self-sufficient. Phase two of our project (from 2013 onwards) will establish the NCH Village as a community centre that will benefit hundreds of local families through care and education.

The need for the Children's Village:

- To provide a safe home to vulnerable children.
- To eliminate the rental costs of four buildings.
- To avoid the uncertainty of eviction by leaseholders from existing rented properties.
- To put all our programs together in one area to reduce management costs.
- To assure the safety, space and materials for healthy child growth.
- To reduce the difficulties and dangers of caring for babies and small children in a multi-storied building.
- To provide high quality health care on site for children and members of the wider community where there are currently no existing facilities.

Current funding situation

So far we have collected ~~US\$~~ **£75,000** (Including Scout - Germany, Wedding fund from Visma Raj Paudel, NCH-IOM and The Philip Green Memorial Trust-UK) towards the purchase of the land.

This is a great achievement for us and is the realization that the Namaste Village is really happening. We still need **£18,208.75** in order to finalize the purchase of the land, which we hope to do during 2010. The new Namaste Village will be located 30 minutes away from our current home. It will include four guest houses for volunteers and staff.
