- Operating hours are Mon to Fri from 9am to 5pm, however with notice, we will endeavour to support service users in the evenings and at weekends.
- Our service is usually one to one but on occasions, small groups may choose to have their sessions together.
- We can support individuals in a wide range of activities, including social groups, swimming, college sessions, visiting libraries and fishing. Whatever the individual wishes to do, we will try to support them to achieve it.
