## Key features

- This Quinney is a purpose built unit on one level, with easy access to the town of Ramsey.
- There are six permanently tenanted & two respite flats, all with a bedroom, lounge, kitchenette and en-suite bathroom. There is also a communal 'tipping' type bath.
- The shops in Ramsey are within easy reach and are on the level from Thie Quinney.
- There is a communal lounge and dining room where an optional evening meal is provided for a small charge.
- Mobile hoists are available, if required.
- There are electric, four-way profiling beds in the respite flats.

## What makes us special

- For adults of all ages with a range of physical disabilities.
- All referrals for permanent & respite tenancies are made through the Adult Disability Team within Social Services. Direct referrals cannot be accepted.
- Flexible, adaptable Individual Service Plans.
- Highly trained and committed staff.
